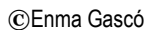

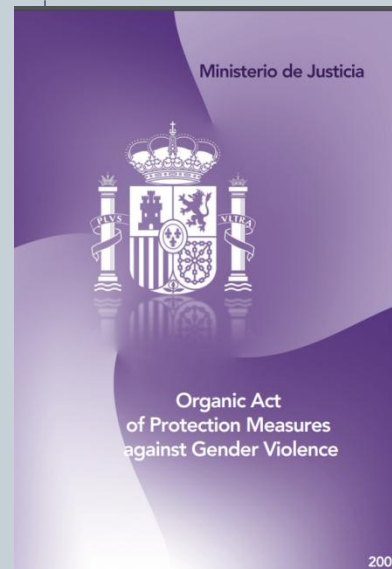
Spanish Parliament

- “...to act against violence that, as a manifestation of discrimination, a situation of inequality and the power relationships men hold over women, is carried out against those who have been their husbands, or those who are or have been connected to them through similar bonds of intimacy, living together or apart” (Section 1.1)

- It was approved **unimously** by the Spanish Parliament.

1. The creation of specific tribunals : Violence Against Women's Courts

“These new Courts will examine and, where appropriate, rule on criminal cases involving violence against women, as well as any related civil causes, such that both are dealt with in first instance before the same bench” (Preamble)”

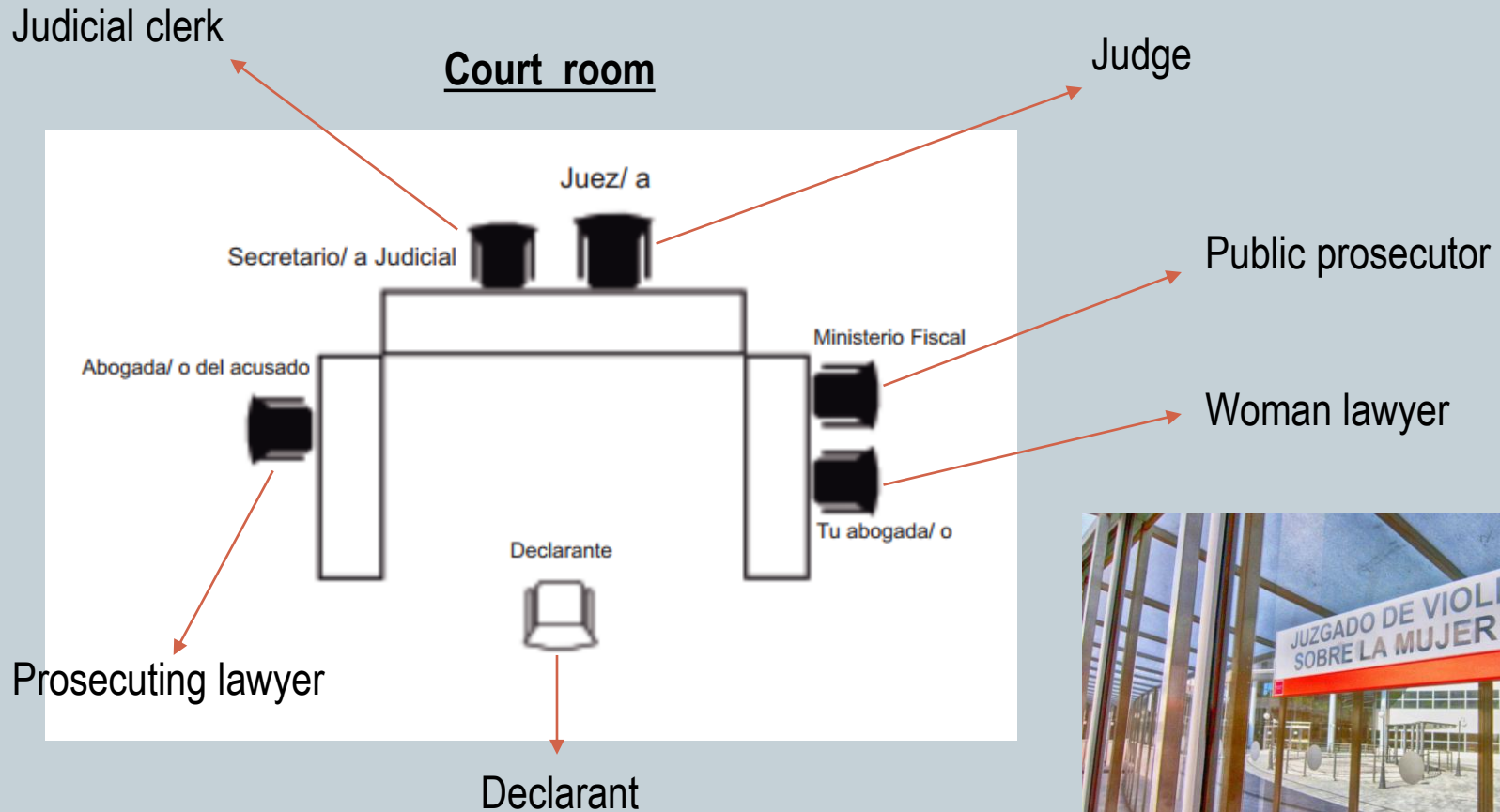


- 106 specific courts

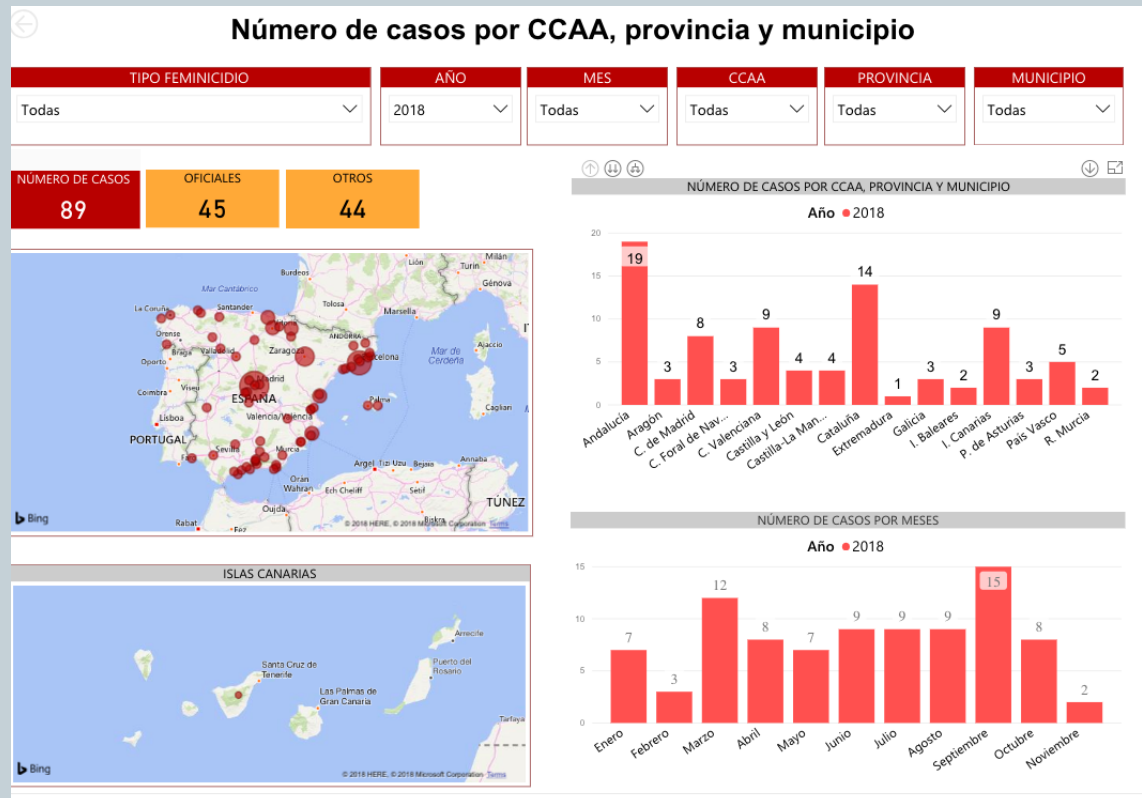

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- In Spain, the average number of women killed each year hits 70 at its worst, but is just of the tip of the iceberg when it comes to the atrocity of violence towards women and their children.
- The specialized courts are still far from giving a victim of constatan infringement of her rights the answer she deserve and is due, for justice, ethics and social responsibility's sake.

2. Guarantee of Victims Rights: “to helping them to put and end to the violent relationship and resume their life plan”

- “These rights are universal, in the sense that they are guaranteed to **all women** who have suffered acts of domestic violence, **regardless of their origin, religion or any other personal or social status or circumstance**”



- Right to information
- Right to comprehensive social assistance: assistance, emergency, support and shelter and full recovery.
- Right to immediate and specialized legal aid.
- Right of residence and work authorization, irrespective of migrant women reunited with their husband or partner. Length of the authorization 5 years.
- Right to temporary residence and work authorization on grounds of exceptional circumstances.
- Right to protection.
- And Right to asylum.

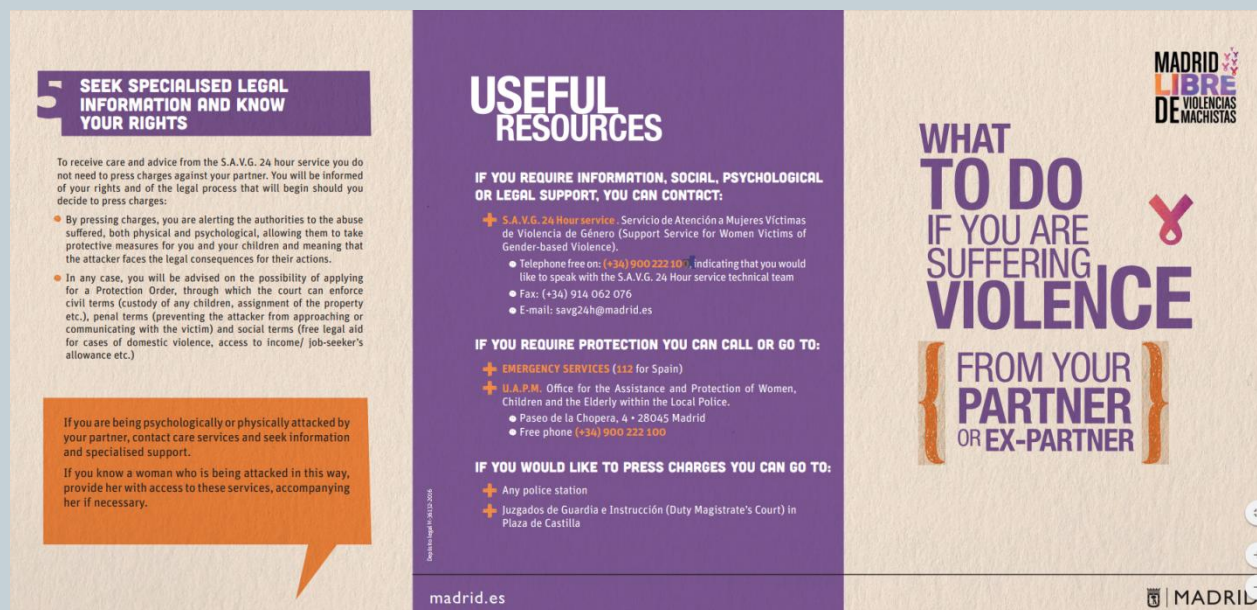

SEEK SPECIALISED LEGAL INFORMATION AND KNOW YOUR RIGHTS

To receive care and advice from the S.A.V.G. 24 hour service you do not need to press charges against your partner. You will be informed of your rights and of the legal process that will begin should you decide to press charges:

- By pressing charges, you are alerting the authorities to the abuse suffered, both physical and psychological, allowing them to take protective measures for you and your children and meaning that the attacker faces the legal consequences for their actions.
- In any case, you will be advised on the possibility of applying for a Protection Order, through which the court can enforce civil terms (custody of any children, assignment of the property etc.), penal terms (preventing the attacker from approaching or communicating with the victim) and social terms (free legal aid for cases of domestic violence, access to income/ job-seeker's allowance etc.).

If you are being psychologically or physically attacked by your partner, contact care services and seek information and specialised support.

If you know a woman who is being attacked in this way, provide her with access to these services, accompanying her if necessary.

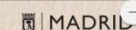

- **012 Mujer:** phone line
- **S.A.VG 24:** hours service (Support Service for Women Victims of Domestic Violence): emergency service
- **Municipal Points of the Regional Observatory on Gender Violence:** They offer information, orientation, psychological care and labor law services for victims of domestic violence at a local (municipality) level.
- **The shelters for victims of domestic violence:** consist of specific, residential and non-residential resources, intended to provide comprehensive care for women, children and dependants who have been victims of domestic violence. The main services provide are accommodation, food, support, psychological care, legal counseling, labor law services and security.

The shelters are composed by residential and non-residential resources:

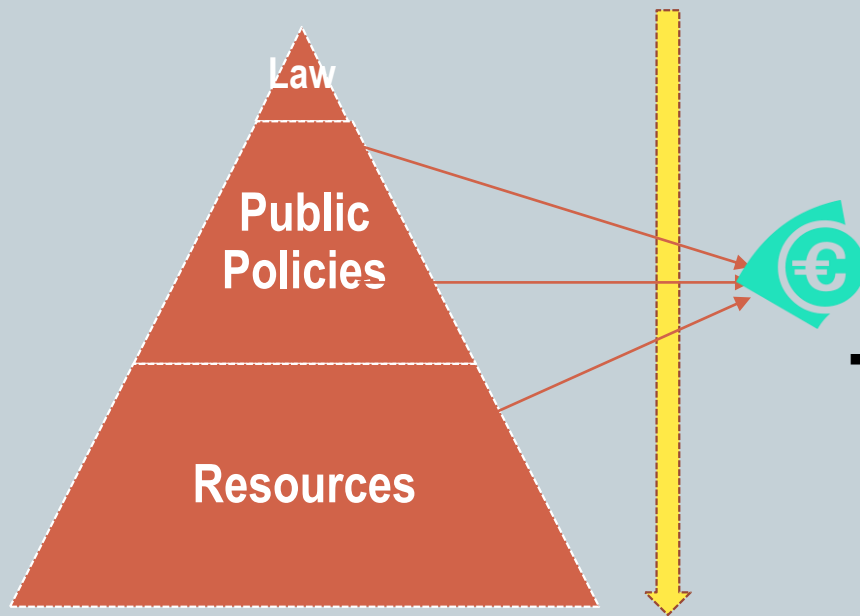
- 1) Emergency shelters: 3 months stay
- 2) Accommodation shelters: 1 year stay
- 3) Protected flat: 1 year stay

➤ **Psychosocial Care Center for victims of Domestic Violence and their children:** It's a specialized psychosocial care resource that aims at the emotional and social recovery of women and their children.

➤ The development of this law and It's implementation requires the commitment of the state, the autonomous communities and the municipal authorities, with adequate **public policies** and **budgetary allocations**.



- National Strategy for the eradication of violence against women (2013-2016): is a backbone of the actions taken by the public authorities to put an end to the violence suffered by women simply because they are women.
